COME, HOLY GHOST!

Meditation

During the period between Easter and Pentecost, the Church has two objectives. She wants to familiarize us with the world beyond, by inviting us to contemplate Jesus risen; and she also wants to prepare us for a new outpouring of the Holy Ghost at Pentecost. Let us therefore ardently desire to receive the Holy Ghost and let us ask Him to fortify our virtue of hope so that we might valiantly carry out our mission over the course of our life. Yes, today more than ever, we have to live by hope. We may not have the happiness of living in a peaceful period, where each one fulfills his duty under the gaze of God, but God nonetheless is still the Master. And history indeed tells us that the moment when all seems lost is the moment when God intervenes. If there was ever a moment when all seemed to be lost, it was Good Friday. The Jewish people had obtained their desire in howling, "Crucify Him, crucify Him!" (Lk. 23:21). The apostles had fled. Jesus had cried out, "My God, My God, why hast Thou forsaken me?" (Mt. 27:46). What a mystery!

And there, at the height of the torment, the Blessed Virgin remained standing at the foot of the

Cross (Jn. 19:25). *Stabat Mater dolorosa*. Thus did she merit the title of "Our Lady of Hope." And her hope was not deceived, since Jesus, faithful in His promises, rose again. Thus, in a period as troubled as our own, though we do not have joy in fullness as in periods of peace, let us cling with confidence to the anchor of hope.

Remember Pontmain in 1871, when the enemy was at the gates of Laval. As all the people in the village sang their hymn to *Our Lady of Hope*, Our Lady offered these few words: "But pray, my children, God will hear you in a little time; my Son lets Himself be moved." And eight days later, against all expectation, the armistice was signed. It was the end of the war against the Prussians and every one of the men of the village of Pontmain who had been on the battlefield came home safe and sound. Likewise, in Fatima, the Blessed Virgin revealed, "In the end, my Immaculate Heart will triumph." To cooperate in this triumph, let us beg the Holy Ghost, invoked in the sequence *Veni, Sancte Spiritus* as "the best of comforters," to come into us and strengthen our hope.
